A light, delicate, floral and slightly honeyed nose with well balanced fruit and a soft, rounded finish.

The palate is soft and well rounded and is smooth and medium to light bodied .

Bin 47. Sangiovese – Vetriano – Puglia – Italy

From Puglia in southern Italy, this easy drinking Sangiovese is open and ripe, with red cherry flavours and a refreshing, round finish.

Bin 48. Merlot – Tonada – Central Valley – Chile

A fruity, medium bodied palate with more plum flavours, a chocolatey note and a twist of spice. Very easy to drink!

Bin 49. Cinsault- Cabernet – Drakensberg – Western Cape – South Africa

A blend of Cinsaut and Cabernet producing a medium bodied wine with bags of soft fruit and character.

Bin 50. Shiraz Cabernet – Red Cliffs – Victoria – Australia

Ripe, rounded, slightly rustic Italian red combining spicy black olives with morello cherry notes and a refreshing acidity.

Bin 58. Carmenere Reserva – Caliterra – Colchagua Valley – Chile

It opens with aromas of black fruits complemented by a soft hint of black pepper, clove, roasted red pepper and tarragon.

Bin 59. Shiraz – Helmsman Robert Oatley – Central Ranges - Australia

A soft fruity Shiraz with aromas of cranberries.

Bin 60. Cotes du Rhone Villages – Arboise– Rhone - France

Vibrant purple colour with bags of black fruits on the nose. Medium to full bodied, with blackberry, cherry and spice flavours, allied to gentle tannins and a fresh, peppery finish.

Bin 65. Valpolicella Superiore DOC – Zenato – Italy

Generous, round aromas of dark cherries, plums, vanilla and coffee - gorgeously chocolatey, ripe and succulent.

Bin 66. Pinot Noir – The Crusher – California – USA

Mouth-wateringly ripe and a silky smooth texture, this Pinot Noir has aromas of wild cherry, raspberry and toasted cedar.

Rich blackcurrant and red fruits, a hint of leather. Balanced acidity and firm tannins

SANDEMANS STORY

In 1790 the 25 year old George Sandeman, son of a Scottish cabinet maker with a £300 loan from his father set up in the port and sherry trade in London. His goal was to make a “moderate fortune to retire with” before the centuries end. This man ended up establishing one of the world’s great wine businesses. He was the founder of Sandeman.

Today, more than 200 years after George Sandeman’s creative impulse, an average of 21 bottles of Sandeman are bought worldwide every minute. Sandeman continues to renew itself and deepening its commitment to combine tradition with the quality and superior class of its wines.

In 1991, English Lakes Hotels Resorts & Venues were close to completion of their new hotel, Lancaster House. All that remained to be decided was a fitting name for the hotel’s bar.

Whilst travelling home from a holiday in Jerez, English Lakes Operations Director, Douglas Dale, was sat beside a man whom, after enquiring into Mr Dale’s occupation, was very interested to find that Lancaster House was being built only a stone’s throw away from the home of a relative. This man was David Sandeman, at the time the Managing Director of Sandeman.

Mr Sandeman was delighted with the idea of naming our bar after his company and graciously accepted the offer to come and open the Sandeman’s Bar, and brought with him the posters and Sandeman memorabilia still on display to this day.

Pale golden straw in appearance, this Viognier is ripe with the aromas of D’Anjou pear, crisp green apple, and honeysuckle .
