DAY ONE

Welcome! Drop your bags and get ready for an adventure. Reach the canopies with 'Treetop Trek' at Brockhole, this high ropes course will have you swinging through the trees and overcoming a range of aerial obstacles before zip lining down to shore.

Once you've handed your harnesses back, head to Low Wood Bay where you can enjoy complimentary entry to the Health Club. The large indoor pool is perfect for children, 'Splash Times' are also hosted with floats and activities to keep the children entertained whilst you supervise from the Jacuzzi or sauna. Please contact the Health Club for times.

Head back to Waterhead to freshen up before dinner, join us in the restaurant to enjoy delicious classic dishes, we also have a special 'Sam's Club' menu just for children.

DAY TWO

Rise and shine with a hearty breakfast, either jump on the bus or drive round to the sweet village of Hawkshead. Monks made this ancient hamlet their home until monasteries were dissolved in 1537, since then the little town has grown into a market town. It is largely a car-free town with little cobbled alleys, quirky homes, homely tea rooms and independent shops hidden away. Hawkshead is home to The Chocolate Factory where you'll be in for a messy treat.

Children and family workshops are available to book. Make your own chocolate bars and use the leftover melted chocolate as face paint. Don't worry, it'll all wash off!

Head back to Waterhead and enjoy a tasty lunch with us, choose from sandwiches, seasonal salads to classic favourites.

Take the short stroll over to the ferry port and jump on a Windermere Lakes Cruise to Lakeside, here you'll find the aquarium. Discover a host of creatures from otters to clownfish.

Take the ferry back towards Waterhead and enjoy an ice cream whilst feeding the ducks on the shorefront.

Tonight, you can take the short walk into the centre of Ambleside and enjoy a family-friendly meal at Dodd's, serving fresh and flavoursome Italian food, or at Fellinis, serving Mediterranean inspired vegetarian dishes.

DAY THREE

Leisurely wake up and start your day with a Waterhead breakfast, check-out by 11am. Jump on the bus or drive round the lake to the tourist town of Bowness-on-Windermere. Don't forget to take your #Boutique Offers leaflet with you to access a range of exclusive offers. Bowness is where you'll find The World of Beatrix Potter attraction, walk through scenes from Beatrix Potter's most famous books and see what's growing in Mr McGregor's garden.

Walk down towards the lake and stop off for an ice cream on the way, take in the views looking down the lake towards Ambleside and stroll along the promenade. There are plenty of cafes and pubs in the town to grab a spot of lunch, we would recommend the Albert or Folk Cafe.

Drive or jump on the bus, through to Ings, where you'll find the Lakeland Farm Visitor Centre, here you can introduce the children to livestock shows, wool spinning experiences as well as a classic farm shop and cafe.
